Action Plan: Student Support Services for Agniveer (IAF)- July 2023 admission session

A. <u>Admission of IAF-Agniveers</u>: As per admission data provided by SRD, 1178 Agniveers from the Indian Air Force (IAF) have enrolled for the July 2023 admission session in the following four programs:

B. <u>Support Services for Agniveers:</u> The 80th Academic Council (AC) in its meeting held on 7th July 2023, gave the following decisions for the conduct of theory/practical counseling and submission of assignments/project for the students enrolled in the skill-based bachelor's degree programs for Agniveers (AC 80.17), as follows:

1. Provision for online academic counseling may be made for the enrolled Agniveers.

2. Provision for online submission of assignments/project may be made. However, in exceptional circumstances, they may be allowed to submit assignments offline.

C. <u>Operational modalities</u>: The following guidelines are to be followed for smooth organization and conduct of student support services :

a) Since the distribution of learners in the four programs is very scattered across the country, Nodal RCs have been identified to provide online academic counseling support in a centralized manner.

b) RC with highest enrolment is the Nodal RC in each of the three programs, i.e., BSCAS-RC Jaipur, BCOMAS-RC Patna and BAASTM- RC Shimla.

c) Five Nodal RCs have been identified zone-wise for BAAS in view of the high enrolment, i.e.,North zone-two nodal RCs, i.e., RC Lucknow & RC Dehradun, East zone-RC Patna, West zone-RC Jaipur and South zone-RC Pune.

d) The RC wise distribution of learners in the above four programs alongwith list of Nodal RCs is attached.

e) The role of the Nodal RC/RC will be as follows:

i. Organize induction meeting, prepare the Induction meeting schedules and inform the learners and RCs.

ii. Conduct online academic counselling for theory courses in the program.

iii. Nodal RC will prepare the counseling schedule and share with the learners and the RCs and place it on the RC website.

iv. For each program having practical courses, the learner will have to complete practical counseling sessions in the LSC under the RC where the learner is enrolled. The RC will prepare the practical counseling schedule and inform the learners.

v. The assignments/projects will be submitted in online mode to the RC where the learner is enrolled and learners may submit offline under exceptional circumstances.
