- 3) Please bring a sum of **Rs 250/- (Rupees two hundred fifty only)** towards the rent and security deposit for Scarf. An amount of Rs 200/- shall be refundable on return of the Scarf at the end of the Convocation.

- 4) The students attending the convocation would wear the existing scarves available at the Regional Centres. However, these students should wear the following dresses to attend the convocation ceremony:
